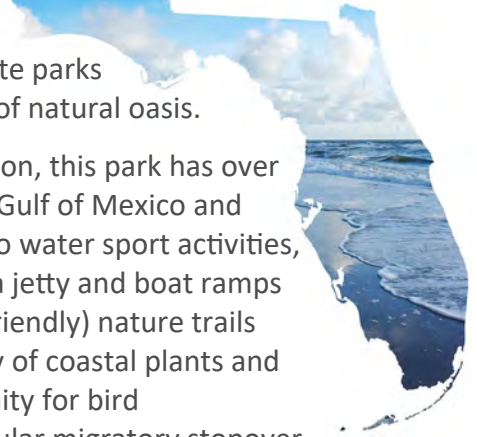

ST. ANDREWS STATE PARK

One of the most popular state parks in Florida. Over 1200 acres of natural oasis.

Formerly a military reservation, this park has over 1.5 miles of beaches on the Gulf of Mexico and Grand Lagoon. In addition to water sport activities, there are two fishing piers, a jetty and boat ramps for avid anglers. Two (pet-friendly) nature trails wind through a rich diversity of coastal plants and provide a splendid opportunity for bird watching. The park is a popular migratory stopover for numerous bird and butterfly species. Check out the website for additional park info, hours of operation, volunteer opportunities and more.
